

Dining Terms and Conditions

Menu and Pricing

- For all dining reservations for over 30
 persons, all parties may be required to order
 from a set or reduced menu. This is for ease
 and speed of service for all parties.
- So we can do our best to accommodate you, please let staff know of any dietary requirements upon arrival. As we operate and prepare food in a commercial kitchen we cannot guarantee against allergic reaction. However having had spoken to allergy suffers, we will always do our best to minimise risk.

<u>Seating</u>

- At the Belair Hotel we will do our best to accommodate large groups however it may not always be possible. The bistro can not accommodate large bookings on platter or cocktail menu's due to dining capacity. For events of these sorts, we recommend speaking with our function coordinator by emailing us on bistro@belairhotel.com.au
- Currently the Belair Hotel does not have a private function room, but we still welcome special occasions and will do our best to accommodate requests.

Corkage and Cakeage

- For wines purchased from the Thirsty Camel bottle shop, a \$15 corkage fee applies. For wines NOT from our bottle shop a corkage fee of \$20 per bottle applies.
- We welcome you to bring your own celebration cake. A charge of \$10 per cake applies and The Belair Hotel will present cake on a platter with cutting knife, cake plates, forks and napkins. Any further service such as cake cutting will be charged on application.

Deposit and Confirmation

- For large group bookings, a deposit may be required.
- Management reserves the right to withhold deposits should all guests fail to arrive as booked.

Cancellation Policy

- The Belair Hotel will retain the full deposit as a cancellation fee, if less than the minimum notice of 24 hours is given.
- If notice of less than 48 hours is given you will incur a loss of 50% of deposit.
- Management reserves the right to withhold 50% of a party's deposit, if your booking should significantly decrease in numbers upon arrival.
